Minnesota Housing Finance Agency (MHFA) Request:

• Challenge Program -- A flexible tool used for the development and preservation of multi and single family housing statewide

\$5M -- Increase (one time)

 Homework Starts with Home -- Supports collaborative efforts between schools, housing organizations, and local governments to identify, engage, and stabilize students experiencing homelessness and their families

\$3.5M -- Base Funding

• Family Homeless Prevention and Assistance Program (FHPAP) -- Rental assistance funding to serve adults, youth and children at risk of experiencing homelessness

\$3.5M -- Increase

• Bridges -- Funds necessary rental assistance for adults with serious mental illness

\$500K -- Increase

• Workforce Homeownership Minnesota (WHOM) -- Provides funding support for statewide affordable home ownership development and rehabilitation

Department of Human Services (DHS) Request:

• Emergency Services Program (ESP) -- Funds emergency shelters and homeless support programs (low barriers, etc.)

\$3M -- Increase (one time)

Bonding Request:

Housing Infrastructure Bonds (HIB) -- Preservation of federally subsidized rental housing, construction
of permanent supportive housing for people experiencing or at risk of homelessness, and for Community
Land Trust land acquisitions for single family home ownership
