# 2019 MCH Legislative Outcomes

## **\$3 Million** Investment to the Emergency Services Program

Emergency shelters are the starting point to gaining long-term stability. With lodging on a short-term basis (usually less than three months), emergency shelters provide a homeless individual or family with a clean, safe place to stay.

# **\$100/Month** Increase to the Minnesota Family Investment Program

The Minnesota Family Investment Program (MFIP), is the state's welfare-to-work program. MFIP cash assistance hasn't increased since 1986. MFIP provides employment support and temporary cash assistance to children and their parents who are striving toward full-time employment.
